To whom it may concern,

As the Member of Parliament for Auckland Central, I sent a survey to my Great Barrier Island constituents. Below I outline the results I have received to the question "Do you support removing parts of the Te Ahumuta Plateau area (as outlined in the discussion paper) from Schedule 4 so that applications for exploration and mining activity can be considered on a case-by-case basis?"

Of the 539 surveys sent out, 81 completed surveys were returned on deadline. I attach the results of this survey in a table below for your information.
